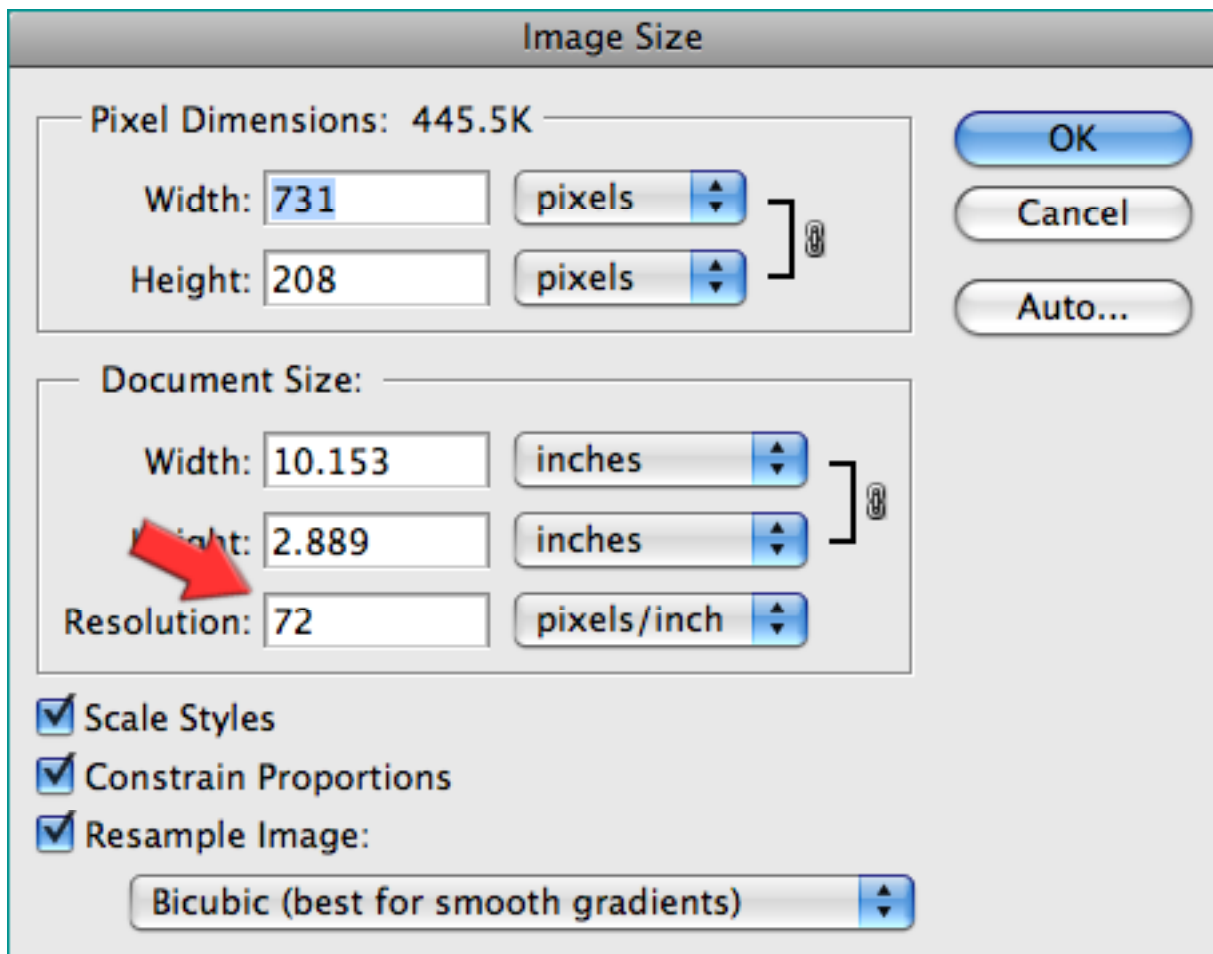


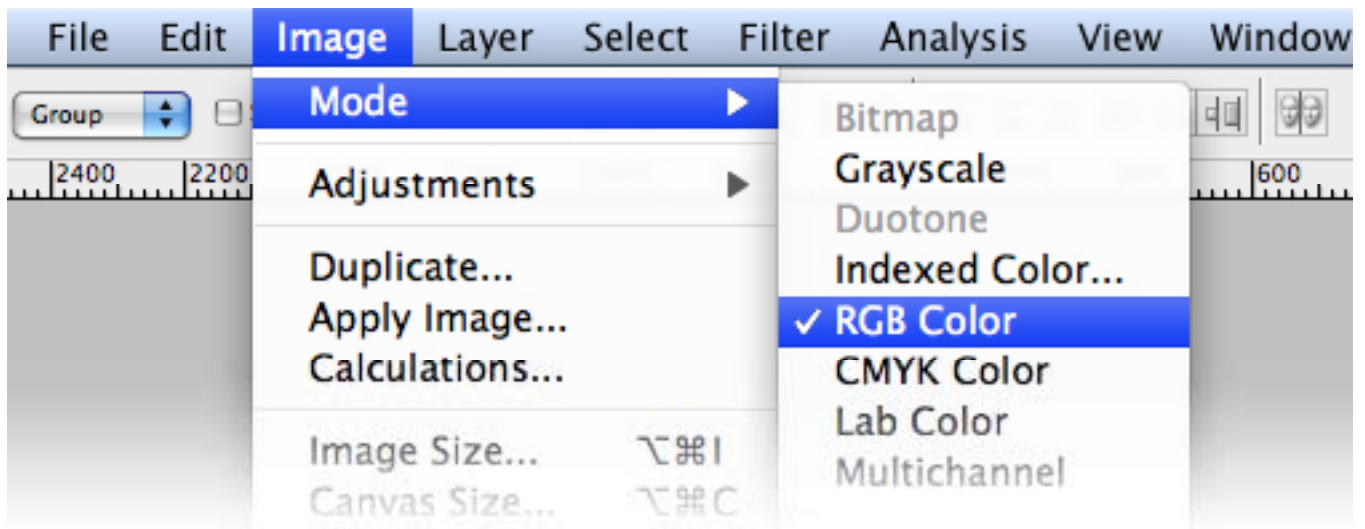
02. Instructions on preparing images for the points of interest

1. To prepare images to appear as points of interest on the panoramas you need to prep them to meet the requirements. The images have to be within the bounds of 950x600px and less than 500KB (lower file sizes perform better, so it's best to keep them down).
2. In Photoshop open up the image you want to edit by going File, then Open on the top navigation. First of all you need to make sure that the image is 72dpi, as this is the resolution used for images on the web. Go to Image, Image Size on the top menu and then change the Resolution to 72dpi if it is higher.



3. Whilst still in the image size pop up, you can adjust the dimensions of the actual image. Make sure that the 'Constrain Proportions' box is ticked so that any changes you make to the size stay in proportion. The maximum size the image can be is 950x600, so for example you would enter 800 into the width field and then because the proportions are constrained the height would be adjusted accordingly.

- Now that your image is saved to the correct size you need to make sure that it is the correct colour profile, go to Image, Mode and select RGB from the top menu. This is the colour profile of web and it is important that this is set or it will cause problems when uploading.



- Now go to File, Save For Web and Devices (Save For Web in older versions of Photoshop) and set the file type to jpeg and the quality to 100%, the file size needs to be lower than 500KB so reduce the quality from 100% until your file is lower than 500KB. Hit Save and name it accordingly, and you are ready to upload it to the WLI site.
